LIVING THE MISSION

Choristers at St. Paul the Apostle is part of a global network developed through the Royal School of Church Music in England. As part of our training, we use a curriculum called Voice for Life. In addition to rehearsing our music, we discuss musical notation, how to read and interpret the musical score, as well as the skills and attitudes that go into be a good, responsible member of a choir. And we explore the Christian faith as expressed in the words we sing.

This being our first year for the Chorister program, all of us worked together through the first level of training, and I am very happy and proud to report that all of our Choristers have successfully completed this introductory level. To recognize this achievement, each of the Choristers have been awarded a medal, on which is an image of St. Nicholas, the patron saint of Choristers.
